

Confidence in breach detection is not stopping breaches




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What we found

100% of healthcare IT leaders rated breach detection Excellent or Good. 58% were breached.

Not one leader rated detection Fair or Poor: 48% said Excellent, 52% said Good. In the same sample, 58% reported an email breach in the past 24 months. When asked what changed afterward, 47% named stronger encryption as their top action, ahead of training or new tooling.




What it means for buyers

-  **Detection scores leave no room**
100% rated breach detection Excellent or Good, with 48% Excellent and 52% Good.
-  **Breaches happened anyway**
58% of the same organizations reported an email-related breach in the past 24 months.
-  **The fix they reached for was encryption**
47% strengthened encryption policies after a breach, their top action over training or tooling.

WHY PAUBOX

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plaintext sends. Every outbound Paubox email is encrypted by default.

-  **Prevention by default**
Every outbound email is encrypted before it leaves, closing the gap detection misses.
-  **Inbound Email Security**
Behavioral AI flags phishing and impersonation that reputation filters let through.
-  **HITRUST certified**
Annual third-party audit of every control.
