

# What healthcare expects HIPAA to require next

Leaders expect audits, multi-factor authentication, and mandated encryption to define the next two years.

## What we found

Leaders expect regular audits (64.24%), multi-factor authentication (59.60%), and mandated encryption (52.98%) to lead HIPAA's next changes.

The anticipated changes point one direction: stronger, more prescriptive controls. Organizations that treat encryption and auditing as optional today will be behind when the requirements arrive.

## What it means for buyers



### Audits move to the center

64.24% expect regular compliance audits to be required.



### Encryption becomes mandated

52.98% expect data encryption to be explicitly required.



### Privacy expectations rise

52.32% expect stronger patient data privacy requirements.
